

## Module 1: The Science of Life

See Appendix B, p. 669, for Module #1 supplies. Note: A microscope will be required, beginning on Day 6, and will continued to be used throughout this course.

- Day 1: Read student notes on pp. vii-x. Peruse Table of Contents and Welcome on pp. xi-xxv. Begin Module 1 on p. 1 and stop before *Proper Handwashing Technique* on p. 8.
- Day 2: Begin at *Proper Handwashing Technique* on p. 8 and stop at *Why Study Science* on p. 14.
- Day 3: Begin at *Why Study Science* on p. 14 and stop at Homeostasis on p. 20. **Be sure to complete all *On Your Own* questions as you work through this text.**
- Day 4: Begin at Homeostasis on p. 20 and stop after completing *On Your Own* questions 1.7-1.9 on p. 23.
- Day 5: Begin at Tools of Biology on p. 24 and stop before Experiment 1.1 on p. 28.
- Day 6: Do **Experiment 1.1, parts A and B**, on pp. 28-30. Remember to follow the directions for experiments on pp. viii-ix; you won't be reminded of this in the upcoming modules.
- Day 7: Do **Experiment 1.1, parts C and D**, on pp. 31-32. Then complete the module, which ends on p. 33.
- Day 8: Do Study Guide questions 1-3 on p. 35 and have them checked. Begin studying for the test.
- Day 9: Do Study Guide questions 4-15 on pp. 35-36 and have them checked. Continue studying for the test.
- Day 10: Take Module 1 test. **Make sure you have the supplies for Module 2 (Appendix B, pp. 669-670).**
