

Module 1: The History of Science – Search for the Truth

Make sure you have supplies listed on p. 411 of textbook.

- Day 1: Read student notes on p. v-viii. Peruse Table of Contents on pp. ix-xvii. Read pp. xix-xxi. Begin Module 1 on p. 1 and stop after completing *On Your Own* question 1.1 on p. 5.
- Day 2: Begin at True Science Begins to Emerge: 600 BC-AD 500 on p. 5 and stop after completing **Experiment 1.1** on p. 7. Be sure to follow instructions on p. vii for writing about your experiments (also see p. 29). No further reminders will be given.
- Day 3: Begin with Hypothesis on p. 8 and stop after completing *On Your Own* questions 1.2 & 1.3 on p. 12.
- Day 4: Begin at Science Progress Stalls and Then Gets Moving Again: AD 500-1500 on p. 12, continue through **Experiment 1.2** on pp. 13-14, and stop at End of the Dark Ages on p. 15.
- Day 5: Begin at End of the Dark Ages on p. 15 and stop at The Era of Newton: AD 1600-1735 on p. 19.
- Day 6: Begin at The Era of Newton: AD 1600-1735 on p. 19 and stop at Modern Science: AD 1900-Present on p. 24.
- Day 7: Begin at Modern Science: AD 1900-Present on p. 24 and complete the module, which ends on p. 28.
- Day 8: Do the Study Guide questions on pp. 30-32 and have them checked. Begin studying for the test.
- Day 9: Continue studying for the test, which will be administered during the next class.
- Day 10: Take Module 1 test. **Make sure you have the supplies for Module 2, which are listed on p. 411.**
